<p style="text-align: center;">School Entry Assessment</p> <p>Within 5-8 weeks of your child starting school at 5 years old, there will be an informal meeting to let you know how your child has settled into school and to share the results of their School Entry Assessment. A similar assessment and follow up meeting will be held when they turn 6.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Term Reflection (Linc Ed)</p> <p>A summary statement (general comment) will be sent home via Linc-Ed that explains how your child has settled into the year and then similar reflections will be posted each term. This will be based around our Learner Qualities and PRIDE Values. This was traditionally done once per year, now this is at least 4 times per year.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Tracking information (replaces mid-anniversary paper report) via Linc Ed</p> <p>This outlines how they are progressing towards their anniversary (birthday) report and is measured against the National Standards core curriculum areas (Reading, Writing, Maths). This will be sent home after approximately 20 weeks, 60 weeks, and 100 weeks at school. (Effectively 6 months after their birthday). <i>Optional</i> meeting for parents offered at this time.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Anniversary information (replaces written anniversary report) via Linc Ed</p> <p>This outlines how they are achieving against the National Standards in core curriculum areas (Reading, Writing, Maths). This information will be shared around the end of their 1st, 2nd and 3rd year at school (after approximately 40 weeks, 80 weeks, and 120 weeks at school). (Around their birthday.) A Parent/Student/Teacher meeting will be requested by school.</p>


